New York Yankees

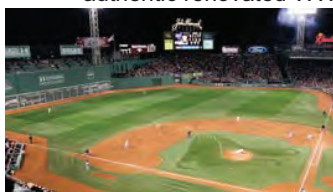
We will be having a trip to see the Yankees at the Stadium. Date and time will be announced. Call our office and put your name on our list. When we secure the date, we will call you.
